

EYFS (Pre-Nursery to Reception)

We have a curriculum for our young learners (aged 2.5-5) which is the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework. This curriculum was originally introduced in the UK as an educational stage for young children.

Cambridge International Primary Curriculum (Year 1-6)

Cambridge Primary is an international education programme, typically for young learners aged 5 to 11 years and is used in primary schools around the world. It develops young learners who are confident, responsible, reflective, innovative and engaged.

In addition to the Cambridge Primary Curriculum, Invictus International Programme also incorporates Singapore Mathematics pedagogy into our curriculum. This teaching method, rooted in the national mathematics curriculum of Singapore primary schools emphasises mastering mathematical concepts in greater depth. Students engage with these concepts through a structured three-step learning process known as the "Concrete-Pictorial-Abstract (CPA)" approach.

Invictus offers a holistic education through in-class learning, field trips, school celebrations, physical **Extra-Curricular** education 3 Activities (ECAs), providing our students with opportunities to develop their personal values and social skills beyond the classrooms. Reading -	word recognition, decoding, and comprehension

Mathematics -	counting, arithmetic, fractions, patterns, algebra, measures, shape and space, and data handling
Arithmetic -	addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division
Developed Ability -	picture vocabulary and non-verbal reasoning
Attitudes -	students' attitudes to reading, maths, and school
